## **Anne KG Murphy and Brian Gray are 2010 TAFF Delegates!**

The 2010 TAFF race has closed and Anne Murphy and Brian Gray are the 50th Elected TAFF delegates! They will be attending the 2010 Eastcon at Heathrow. The voting breakdown is on the second page. There was a significant use of the PayPal option and I'm hoping other administrators will continue to keep paypal as an option. 29 of this year's voters came through PayPal for a total of 164 dollars out of the total 490 dollars that were raised in donations along with votes. Last votes came in at 11:52pm, 8 minutes to spare.

As for total finances of the fund, I don't have a full report, partly due to not having Canadian funds transferred yet (waiting on a better exchange rate) and we're still waiting on a 277 dollar transfer from Anticipation as well. The total in the account, after the 2486.29 from the Tuckerization auctions that this year's candidates put together, and the 190.00 Anne Murphy put together at WindyCon and small auctions at LosCon (34 dollars). The cost of mailing TAFF ballots was

68 dollars including envelopes. The disastrous mailing problems (outlined in Drink Tank 232) isn't included in that number, since it was an utter failure.

The total, though, is 14,202.39, as of December 23rd. That's the highest I think the Fund has ever managed to achieve.

I'd like to give thanks to many folks who helped out on this race and for helpign to increase the fund, especially Frank and Anne and Brian for being such great candidates, raising more money in the space of a month than I had my entire administrationship and raising the profile of TAFF. I'm always glad when we can do that. I also want to thank LosCon, and especially Marcia Minsky and Sherri Bounain for their donations and help. And, as always, Leigh Ann Hildebrand, for the Scarf, which sold at Anticipation, Espana Sheriff for the Logo, Linda Wenzelburger for all her help, Jason Schachat, Joel Zakem, John Scalzi, Paul Cornell, Steve and Sue Francis, Chris Barkley, M Lloyd, Steve Green, Steven H.
